## **Craft**

Have your children make cards for the workers at the hospital. Include colorful messages and pictures to brighten their day. Also, Scripture would be great.

## **Activity**

- **Prayer Stations** - Help your family set up prayer stations around your house. Use stuffed animals, print pictures, matchbox cars, etc. to display who you will be praying for. For example- nurses, doctors, hospital workers, teachers, parents, city mayors, state governors and the president. Lead your children in praying over each job/person. Also, allow your child to lead you in prayer.
- **Praise Wall** - Using a large sheet of paper or many pages have your child/children write on the wall all of the good things they are thankful for and they have in their lives. Also for all the good things the first responders in our communities do. Explain that praying is also about thanksgiving, worship and praise too.

## **Discussion-**

- **Ask them what they thought about the prayer stations.**
- **Ask them what they thought of the prayer wall.**
- **Which one they liked the most? The least?**
- **Why does God want us to pray to Him? (so we can have a relationship with Him)**
- **Does God like it when we pray to Him? (Yes, it helps us learn more about Him)**
- **When can we pray to Him? (all the time)**
- **What are some things we can talk about with God when we pray? (Allow for answers)**
