Themes in Creation Narrative

 Kingdom – God's people in God's place under God's rule and blessing

• Covenant – A chose relationship/partnership in which two parties making binding promises to each other and work together to reach a common goal.



Order of Creation

Form	Filling
Day 1 - Separating day & night	Day 4 – Sun & Moon for day & night
Day 2 – Separating sky & sea	Day 5 – Sky animals & sea animals
Day 3 – Separating land & sea	Day 6 – Land animals & humans
Day 7 – Sabbath Rest	



Framework Theory

- 1) Command "God said"
- 2) Report "It was so"
- 3) Assessment "It was good"
- 4) Dominion "God called"
- 5) Time marker "Evening and morning"
 - 7TH day looks different
